

On February 20, 2022 Chloe Wall was reported missing by her father, Cary Wall. Mr. Wall stated that his daughter had went missing two days prior. Chloe Wall has been identified as a chronic runaway, has intentionally gone missing and has been located numerous times in the past. Sergeant Hoag did not let Walls history deter him from conducting his investigation. Sergeant Hoag interviewed numerous relatives, friends and neighbors and closely monitored social media accounts of those who may have had information regarding Wall's whereabouts. Additionally, Sergeant Hoag coordinated with numerous agencies, to include the FBI, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, Mohawk Valley Crime Analysis Center, Child Protective Services, Oneida County Family Court and sought assistance from the media in an attempt to located Chloe and bring her home safely. Sergeant Hoag was in constant contact with Chloe's family and friends in order to expedite the investigation process. Many of the hours spent conducting the investigation was done during Sergeant Hoag's personal time. Due to the dedication and perseverance of Sergeant Hoag, Chloe Wall was ultimately located and safely returned home to her family on March 17, 2022.
