During the course of the traffic stop it was discovered that Zygmunt was operating the vehicle with a suspended driver's license. While further conducting the traffic stop narcotic paraphernalia was observed, which led to a vehicle search. During the search a quantity of narcotics was located. Zygmunt was taken into custody and charged with Aggravated Unlicensed Operation and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 2nd Degree.
