

On behalf of the administration, Officer Zachary Hadasz has been awarded the recognition of Officer of the Quarter. On March 14, 2023, Officer Hadasz observed a female operating a 2020 Chevrolet Sedan in the 300 Blk. Of Turin Street. After committing a violation of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, a traffic stop was conducted. While speaking with the female it was determined that she had an outstanding warrant issued from Rome City Court and was operating the vehicle with a suspended driver's license. The female was taken into custody and transported to Rome Police Headquarters. During the process Officer Hadasz located a large quantity of narcotics, which included 167 Grams of Methamphetamine and glassine envelopes containing fentanyl. The female was subsequently charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 2nd degree.
